ACT I

In his place Raymonda sees an Eastern knight who declares his love to her...

ACT II

Festivities are underway at the castle.

Among the guests is the Saracen knight, Abderakhman, accompanied by a magnificent suite. Terrified, Raymonda recognizes him to be the mysterious stranger of her dream. Abderakhman offers Raymonda power and riches in return for her hand and heart but she rejects him. Enraged, Abderakhman tries to abduct her. Fortunately, Jean de Brienne has returned from the crusade. King Andrei II suggests that the two rivals settle their differences in single combat. Jean de Brienne gets the better of Abderakhman and the lovers are united again.

ACT III

King Andrei II blesses the marriage of Raymonda and Jean de Brienne. During the festivities, he is honoured with a big Hungarian dance.
